EAST CHICAGO COMMON COUNCIL ORDINANCE NO. 2024-21
AN ORDINANCE REPEALING
THE CITY OF EAST CHICAGO WELCOME CITY ORDINANCE NO. 17-010

WHEREAS, in 2017, this Common Council passed Ordinance No. 17-010 in an effort to let community know that they should feel safe calling the City of East Chicago and all of its supportive and public safety services regardless of any of the rhetoric following the 2016 election; and

WHEREAS, the City of East Chicago remains committed to upholding the Constitutions of the State of Indiana and the United States, to upholding the laws of the State of Indiana, protecting the rights of its residents and visitors, and to ensuring the health and safety of all residents and visitors to our; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that Ordinance No. 17-010 is not effective or necessary for the protection of the rights of residents and visitors nor to ensure the health and safety of all residents and visitors.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EAST CHICAGO, INDIANA, THAT THE CITY OF EAST CHICAGO WELCOME CITY ORDINANCE NO. 17-010 IS HEREBY REPEALED IN ITS ENTIRETY.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of passage and publication according to law.
